REPORT FROM LIAISON TOWN BOARD: John E. Johnson, II.

- Mr. Johnson arrived at the meeting (7:18PM) due to another commitment. He reported Town in process of conducting a public auction to liquidate some 50+ vehicles removed 4 years ago from the former Wickes property. Auction to be conducted on-line by Wilcox auctioneers of Bergen, N.Y.
- Mr. Johnson advised the Board that we will be seeing small pink flags in various areas of the district. These indicate where core samples are being gathered in anticipation of the new water lines.

FIRE CHIEF'S REPORT:

• Engine 62 currently out of service due to mechanical issues that occurred returning from barn fire on 03/10. Firematic rep in contact with Cummins engine, believe to be a turbo or turbo actuator issue;

Recent significant fires:

- Barn fire at the Stein Farms on Gully Road on 03/10 was successfully controlled by quick action by farm worker and the fire department. Mutual aid from 5 departments; Good Job by all;
- LeRoy Manor: call with actual smoke conditions; staff did not call FD. Staff reminded of early notification to FD is essential. New policy consists of "shelter-in-place" where residents email in their room. A better method of accountability versus evacuation or shelter in stark towers; similar policies in place for both "Rose Villa" 43 Mill Street and The Greens, Willow Ridge Senior Living complex;
- Power pole and lines down (ProFac Park) with major power disruption throughout the village-over 3 hours in total. During this incident the Emergency generator at the Station and Village Hall complex failed to start after three power interruptions. Stark Power Systems in to evaluate situation.
- To be noted: The crews did an excellent job at the Stein Farms incident, good cooperation and interaction. Of note the "after call" workload in putting apparatus and equipment back in service.

- Vendor MES has notified the office that the new {replacement) air bags to be delivered by end of month. Training and orientation to follow;
- Assistant Chief Pfendler requested the Board to request a review of various intersections be reviewed for additional signage due to an increase in the number of accidents at these locations: West Bergen and Randall; West Bergen and Selden/Thwing; and West Bergen and Griswold Road. Secretary to draft letter for review;

• Fire Fighter Physicals: Mr. Bater noted during the audit of the bill that there has been a significant price increase in the cost of basic firefighter physicals from our vender. Chief Pfendler confirmed that the 2025 cost per firefighters in now at \$173.00.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Chief Pfendler reported on the status of the 702 replacement vehicle. A modification in the original specification involves changing from a pickup truck design to an SUV (2025 Ford Expedition). Reduced cost and vehicle capability features cited as the main reason.
